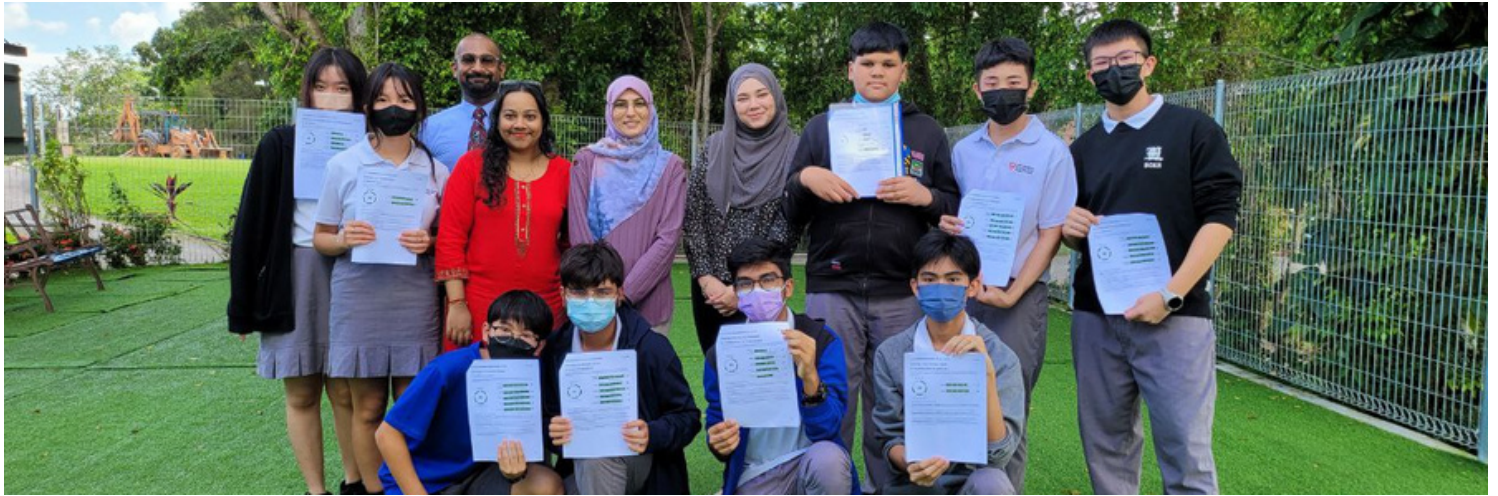

### Looking Ahead to Key Stage 4

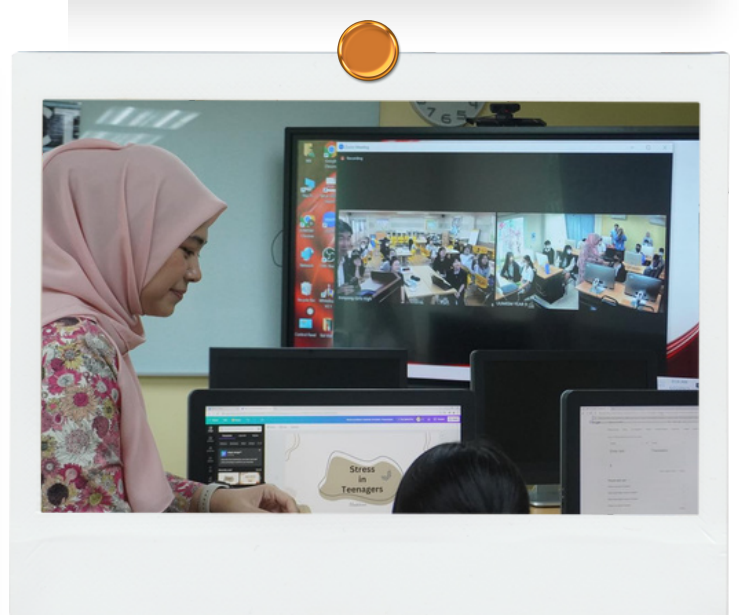
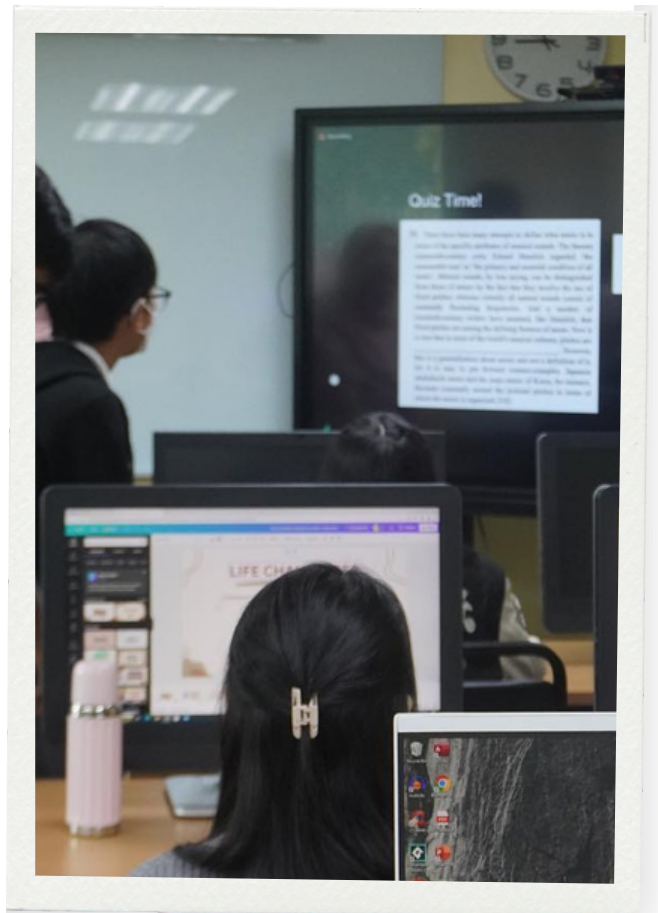
