
With cleverly placed clues hidden across their classroom and common areas, teachers had a blast hunting for hints and uncovering surprises

Finally, everyone present participated in a Kahoot quiz created by the Year 8s about members of the school community.



Well done, Anis. You've made UUMISM proud!








The event also explored Cambridge's learner attributes and practical tools to support higher-order thinking and independent learning.
