## **UUM International Secondary School Melaka** Triumphs at AIIRC 2025












On Tuesday, 24 June, The Airborne Innovation International RC Jet (AIIRC) 2025 took Competition place on 25-26 June 2025 at Politeknik Merlimau, Melaka. This exciting two-day international event brought together passionate (remote-controlled) builders and flyers from around world to showcase their creativity and engineering skills.

The competition was split into two parts. On Day 1, teams were given time to build their RC jets using lightweight materials Depron foam and other easy-to-find materials. This allowed participants to design their own aircraft from scratch, creativity and encouraging hands-on learning.









On Wednesday, 25 June, teams competed in a flying challenge where the jets were tested for flight stability, control, and overall performance.

UUM International School Melaka proudly represented their school and performed exceptional<mark>ly well, winning 6th Place in Best</mark> Design and 6th Place in Best Flight categories. These awards recognized the team's effort in both engineering design and flying skills, a fantastic achievement on an international stage.



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The AIIRC competition is not only about winning but also about learning, experimenting, and pushing the boundaries of what young minds can create. By using affordable materials and encouraging open-ended designs, the event makes RC aviation accessible to more students and hobbyists around the world.



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More than just a competition, AIIRC 2025 was a great learning experience. It gave participants the chance to improve their knowledge in aircraft design, aerodynamics, and flight control, while also building teamwork and problem-solving skills.

Congratulations to our UUM International Secondary School Melaka team for making us proud and showing what young innovators can achieve in the skies!




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## **University Exploration Trip: A Day of Discovery**

On 24 June 2025, twenty-four of our Years 9, 10, and 11 students, accompanied by six teachers, embarked on a day-long academic exploration to Taylor's University and the University of Nottingham Malaysia.



#### Afternoon at University of Nottingham Malaysia

At Nottingham, students attended a detailed admissions briefing and explored facilities including engineering labs, creative arts studios, and lecture theatres. The highlight was an interactive economics game led by a professor, where students negotiated prices, managed resources, and experienced market dynamics firsthand. They also had an informal Q&A session with current undergraduates on student life, clubs, internships, and global opportunities.





#### Morning at Taylor's University

Students began with a warm welcome and a campus orientation, followed by a Social Media in Business workshop. In teams, they analysed real-world campaigns, created mock strategies, and presented their ideas to university lecturers, who gave constructive feedback on content tone and hashtags. A guided campus tour showcased cutting-edge labs, multimedia suites, and degree offerings—providing a real sense of academic life and facilities.



#### Reflections



#### Day Two: Championship Tees Off at AKCC




