

- Official Winner: Fun, laughter, and maybe a few paint splats in unexpected places











Here's to more days that combine learning, laughter, and a little friendly fire!






proud moment marks significant milestone not just for Teuku, but also for UUMISM as a whole. We're confident that this is only the beginning of an incredible journey ahead.
